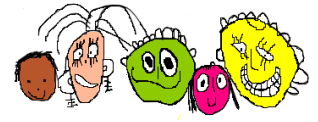

Seemore Safety Program

National Quality Standard – Quality Area 2

Element 2.2.2 – Incident and emergency management. Plans to effectively manage incidents and emergencies are developed in consultation with relevant authorities, practised and implemented

The KIDS Foundation Seemore Safety Program is an early year's safety and risk education program. The program aims to foster a belief in children, students and teachers that injuries and incidents are predictable and preventable. It strives to nurture a "think safe, play safe" attitude and encourages students to assess their environment and take responsibility for their own safety. A skill that will become invaluable throughout their whole lives.

The Seemore Safety Program assists educators and children to identify hazards and consider the risks in their everyday environment. It focuses on learning through literature and real-life experiences.

Children interact with the Seemore Safety mascot to learn about safe practises and injury risks.

The Seemore Safety Pre-School Objectives are

- To increase safety awareness and knowledge of safe practices, resulting in positive behaviour change
- To enhance risk management skills that improve the ability of children to recognise safe and unsafe situations
- To provide an avenue for safety discussions, which result in an increased awareness of safety and safe practices.



The program is based around 11 Seemore safety titles being: -

- Seemore Safety in the Car
- Seemore Safety at the Playground
- Seemore Safety at the Beach
- Seemore Safety with a Friend
- Seemore Safety at Pre-School
- Seemore Safety on a Bike

- Seemore Safety on a Farm
- Seemore Safety on Tiny germs we can't See
