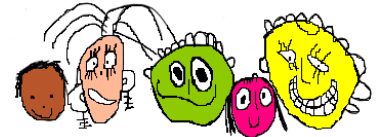

Program Learning Opportunities

National Quality Standard – Quality Area 1

Element 1.1.3 – Program Learning Opportunities. All aspects of the program, including routines, are organised in ways that maximise opportunities for each child's learning.

At Hamilton Community Pre-School we provide a quality curriculum (or program) that is there to support and guide the children in all areas of their development and learning. We consider the child's opinions, thoughts, ideas, culture, interests, strengths and needs.

Our program is flexible to meet the needs of the children and their learning, we have a balance of both in and outdoor play experiences.

Ours is a written daily plan that is posted on Storypark for families to access, it includes jotting of the children's engagement and voices, observations taken, community input, routines and transitions, morning meeting minutes and wellbeing experiences. Experiences can be planned for the following week or spontaneously provided.

Throughout the year we cover many important learning areas such as child protection and safety, ear and dental health etc. Special days and events are celebrated in the Pre-School e.g. Harmony day, Mother's and Father's day etc.

Entries can be of individual achievement or group projects or interactions.
